ACT Scholarship criteria:

- ❖ You must be a Mississippi resident enrolling as a full-time freshman (minimum of 15 semester credit hours) at EMCC for the first time in the fall or spring semester following high school graduation.
- ❖ The scholarship is good for four consecutive semesters if all criteria are continually met.
- ❖ You must maintain full-time enrollment each semester (15 or more credit hours). If you fall below 15 semester hours within the first six weeks of school the scholarship is lost for that semester and any following semester. If you fall below 15 hours following the 6th week of the term you will receive the scholarship for that term but placed on scholarship probation for the following term.
- ❖ The required cumulative grade point average (GPA) for each scholarship awarded must be maintained. If the GPA or 15 hour course load is not met, you will be placed on scholarship probation for the next semester. If the GPA and course load is not met during the probation semester the scholarship is lost.
- ❖ No student will be permitted to receive institutional scholarships for repeated classes that were successfully completed with a grade of C or higher. These repeated classes cannot count toward the 15 semester hour requirement.
