

The East Mississippi Community College Ambassador Program was developed to give current students the opportunity to serve by assisting with recruitment efforts. This is accomplished by participating in high school college fairs, on-campus events, course registration, football game day activities, giving campus tours, and writing prospective students. Additionally, those who participate in the program will have the opportunity to enhance their communication skills, ability to work within a team, and ability to manage time effectively.

Ambassadors register for a one hour credit course, attend standing meetings, and spend one hour a week working in the recruitment office. Ambassadors will also be required to participate in various events throughout the week, at night and some weekends.

To participate in the program and receive the associated scholarship, students must maintain a **3.0 GPA** and finish the semester with a minimum of **15 hours**. Ambassadors serve for one school year and will need to reapply should they want to participate for a second year.


