Dear Faculty, Staff, and Students:

In response to Governor Reeves' revised order, Safer at Home, and explicit guidance that Mississippi schools will remain closed, East Mississippi Community College will continue to await further direction from state officials as to when we might be permitted to bring small groups of students back to campus to complete the hands-on component of their coursework. In the meantime, we will continue to provide quality instruction virtually through Canvas. We appreciate your patience, as we are as eager as you are to return to campus; however, as Governor Reeves shared, it is safer for those who are able to stay at home to do so. We will continue to work closely with state and local officials to develop plans for a safe return to campus when we are able to return for limited face-to-face instruction. If you have an individual question about your specific program, please speak with your instructor. If your instructor is unable to answer your questions, they will refer you to their dean for additional information.
