

TOBACCO FREE EMCC



Smoke-Free/Tobacco Free Campus

In order to promote a healthy environment for students, faculty, staff, and visitors, East Mississippi Community College will be tobacco free on all campuses effective January 1, 2017. The use of tobacco and smoking products will not be permitted on any East Mississippi Community College owned property, which includes, but is not limited to, buildings, grounds, parking areas, walkways, recreational and sporting facilities, and college-owned vehicles. This policy will apply to faculty, staff, students, contractors, visitors, and vendors. This policy will include, but is not limited to, smoke or vapor emitting products, synthetic substances other than tobacco, and smokeless tobacco products. The only exception to the tobacco free policy will be The Lion Hills Center in Columbus, MS, where the use of tobacco is discouraged but will be permissible only for guests in designated exterior areas and on the golf course. Tobacco products and products derived from tobacco are not sold on any campus or at any location operated by EMCC.
