Thank you for considering the Golden Triangle Early College High School Program. Before completing the application, we request that you consider the information below to determine if GTECHS is the right educational environment for your student. Please make special note of the expectations you and your student will be agreeing to if he/she is accepted into the program.

- The GTECHS calendar is aligned with the EMCC calendar and will be different than the calendar in your home district
- We run a modified block schedule aligned with the EMCC schedule. Each class meets only two times each week
 (either Monday and Wednesday OR Tuesday and Thursday). Missing one day of class is the equivalent of missing
 half of the week's instruction. Students must commit to daily attendance to be successful. Fridays are dedicated to
 Seminar classes where students work towards earning the College and Career Readiness credit required by the MS
 Dept of Education.
- This application is designed to help us know more about the students who are applying. There are no right or wrong answers. We truly want to know our students and how we can best serve them. As you will see below, the final selection is made by random lottery.
- All applications will be evaluated. Class members will be notified by mail after the selection process is complete. If
 your mailing address is incorrect you will not receive important selection information and risk missing enrollment
 deadlines. Applications postmarked or delivered after March 7, 2025 will not be considered.

The goal of the Golden Triangle Early College High School (GTECHS) program is to select and admit a diverse group of academically capable students who have a genuine interest in pursuing a unique and rigorous program focused on earning a high school diploma along with an associate's degree and/or career/technical certification. Each application and accompanying documentation will be reviewed by our team. All students with complete applications will be considered and **the final selection will be made by a random lottery process.** Required elements to be included in this application are as follows:

Academic Information: Grades, MAAP or other state test scores and other academic indicators

References: Two from current teachers who have the ability to evaluate the student's potential for success

Application: Well-written, thoughtful responses provided by the student and parents/guardians

Characteristics: Intellectual curiosity, self-motivation, maturity, self-discipline, and the desire for a non-traditional

high school setting
